• After dinner, President Mayer introduced **Mr. Steve Bates**, President of the Vietnam War Memorial Fund, who spoke on the "**Oregon Capitol Vietnam Veterans Memorial.**" A Life Member of the Associates of Vietnam Veterans of America, Mr. Bates served as Chair of the Committee on Memorials and Remembrance over the past 8 years. He reported on the planned Oregon Vietnam War Memorial to be built on the Capitol grounds in Salem, and recounted the actions he took at the 2023 Legislative Session which resulted in a one-million-dollar allocation for the Memorial. Mr. Bates showed a video rendition of the planned memorial, the 2-phase building plan, and the remaining amount of funds necessary for its completion.
